ASSA ABLOY Entrance Systems

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1. Description

The ASSA ABLOY DE6190AR automatic restraint is a hydraulic wheel restraint system that helps to prevent accidents and injuries at the loading bay. During the loading operation there is a risk that the trailer can roll away unintentionally from the dock due to the impact from the forklift truck traffic, a problem known as vehicle creep. Another ever-present danger is premature drive-off, when a truck leaves too early due to misunderstanding, incorrect instruction or a lack of communication with the driver. For both risks the ASSA ABLOY DE6190AR automatic restraint is the ideal solution.

During the dock-in procedure the ASSA ABLOY DE6190AR automatic restraint acts as a parking guide for the reversing truck. This reduces the possibility of damage to the truck, dock shelter, dock leveler or the building. When the truck is in the right position at the dock, the hydraulic wheel restraint system is activated by an impulse push button on the control box, which is located inside the building. The rear wheel is detected and secured automatically by the restraining arm. The outstanding feature of the ASSA ABLOY DE6190AR automatic restraint is the constant restraining force from the hydraulic system that provides a reliable and safe restraint


function during the loading operations.

1.1 Mode of operation

1. Ready for use condition

Outside traffic light is green; the truck can reverse backwards to the loading bay.

The loading operation cannot be started. The sectional door or the dock leveler is blocked for use.






2A. Activate the restraint system (standard)


When the truck is in place, the restraint system is activated by an impulse push button on the control box. When activated a beeper alarm sounds and the outside traffic light switches from green to flashing red to indicate the movement of the restraint system.


When the detection arm contacts the rear truck wheel, the blocking arm extends up to 250 mm in front of the wheel, the carriage moves towards the wheel and blocks the truck with pressure towards the building. Then the outside traffic light switches to red and the inside indication lamp on the control box turns green. The sectional door or the dock leveler is released for use.



2B. Activate the restraint system (optional with mud flap sensor)

When the truck is in place, the restraint system is activated by an impulse push button on the control box. When activated a beeper alarm sounds and the outside traffic light switches from green to flashing red to indicate the movement of the restraint system. When the detection arm contacts the rear truck wheel, the carriage moves towards the wheel. When the mud flap sensor detects the wheel from the front and senses that there is no obstacle, the blocking arm extends just in front of the wheel. Then the outside traffic light switches to red and the inside indication lamp on the control box turns green. The sectional door or the dock leveler is released for use. If there is an obstacle, the blocking arm will not extend but the machine will run back to the parking position. The benefit of the sensor is to avoid damages to trucks with rigid and low hanging mud flaps when parked in the loading bay.








3. Loading operation

Now the loading operation can begin. The sectional door can be opened, and the dock leveler can be connected to the truck.



4. Release the restraint system


When the dock leveler is back to parking position and the door is closed, the release of the restraint system is activated by an impulse push button on the control box.

When activated a beeper alarm sounds and the outside traffic light switches from red to flashing red to indicate the movement of the restraint system.

When the restraint system is back to its parking position the outside traffic light switches to green.

Now the truck can leave and the restraint system is ready for use for the next truck.

The blocking arm can be released manually in case of an interruption to the power supply



Attention


Before activating the restraint system, the operator must be sure that the truck is correctly positioned against the buffers.

Remark:

The restraint system is activated without a vehicle in place, it will automatically move back to its parking position.







- 1) Guide rail

- 8) Additional outside traffic light


1.2.1 Dimensions



1.2.2 Overview of parts










1.2.3 Manual release of the blocking arm

In case of interruption in the power supply, it is possible to release the blocking arm manually to allow the truck to drive off.



1.5 Interlocking functions

- The sensor for the door of the loading bay ensures that
 the restraint system can only be activated when the door
 is closed. In a standard loading process the door is closed
 when the loading operation has finished. Then this
 interlocking function prevents the restraint system from
 being removed too early, so the truck cannot drive off
 too early thereby avoiding possible dangerous situations
 for the forklift truck drivers. This loading process is
 standard in many industries and can be installed either
 with the dock leveler behind the door or outside in a
 loadhouse.
- The sensor for the dock leveler also ensures that the restraint system can only be activated when the door and the dock leveler are closed. In a loading process divided into sequences according to when the goods are ready from production, the door of the loading bay is closed between the sequences while the dock leveler stays connected to the truck. Then this interlocking function prevents the restraint system from being removed too early, so the truck cannot drive off too early thereby avoiding possible dangerous situations for the forklift truck drivers. This loading process is used by some manufacturing companies, and can be installed with the dock leveler outside in a loadhouse.
- The sensor for the truck detection also ensures that the restraint system can only be activated when the truck is in place. This interlocking function prevents the restraint system from moving unintentionally before the truck has arrived in the correct position in front of the loading bay thereby avoiding possible dangerous situations for the people outside in the driving area of the trucks.

1.6 Control Box



Dimensions: HxWxD 500x300x220 mm


- 1) Signal white to indicate power ON.
- 2) Signal green to indicate leveler or sectional door is released (the truck is docked and blocked).
- Push button to activate the restraint system to move forward and block the truck.
 The push button lamp is green when the restraint system is ready for use or when the optional truck detection sensor is activated.
- 4) Push button to release the restraint system to move back to the parking position.
- 5) Push button to RESET the restraint system. Signal blue to indicate an error in the system or when emergency push button has been activated.
- 6) Key switch for maintenance.
- 7) Mains Switch.
- 8) Emergency stop push button.




2. Truck Specifications

The ASSA ABLOY DE6190AR automatic restraint can be used for a large proportion of vehicles with or without tail lift. Trailers with one axle, two axles or three axles, as well as most smaller vehicles down to 3,5 ton.










2.1 Working range of the restraint system

The working range defines the trucks suitable that can be secured by the ASSA ABLOY DE6190AR automatic restraint.



The rear position of the ASSA ABLOY DE6190AR automatic restraint is 100 mm in front of the buffer to allow the operation of trucks with tail lifts. In this position, the distance from the buffer to the rear wheel must be min. 670 mm (570 mm from the wheel detection arm plus 100 mm from the buffer).

The working range of the system depends on the size of the wheel set of the trucks.



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
